

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

All applicants shall:

- **complete the Association's Application Form**
- **abide by the Association's Code of Practice**
- **comply with the Association's Bye Laws**

FULL MEMBERSHIP – Contractors, Manufacturers & Distributors

Companies shall demonstrate a proven track record in the field of concrete repair and meet the other requirements laid down in the Bye laws of the Association.

Each prospective member shall be accredited to ISO 9001 and BSEN 14001.

Contractors are also required to hold current accreditation with the Contractors Health and Safety Scheme (CHAS).

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Specialist firms and companies, which do not qualify for full membership eg testing houses, engineers, building surveyors, consultants, and manufacturers of ancillary products, may apply for Associate membership.

Overseas contracting companies engaged in concrete repair which do not have a UK office may also apply.

Each application will be vetted by the Executive Committee.

FEES

Membership subscriptions are charged from 1st July to 30 June each year. Members joining the Association after 1 January will be charged on pro rata basis. Invoices for subscription for new members will be sent on appointment to membership.
