

CRA UPDATES ROAD SHOW PRESENTATION SUITE

Hot on the heels of the introduction of a new CD, containing audio-visual programmes on concrete repair techniques and allied disciplines, the **Concrete Repair Association (CRA)** has announced the re-launch of its CPD certificated Road Show programmes.

The presentation series now includes three important, yet quite different, remedies for ailing concrete. They are typically presented to professional groups, in their premises, at mutually convenient date and time (normally lunch periods), by specialist CRA contractor and CRA product manufacturer members, provided a minimum of four delegates are able to attend.

Each presentation, about 45 minutes in duration, is specifically designed to give an insight into concrete repair techniques and allied refurbishment procedures.



They have been produced for the benefit of specifiers, contractors and owners of structures/buildings containing concrete components who need a brief introduction to the methods and just as importantly, the critical matters to be taken into account when looking at specific projects.

The first programme, an entirely new presentation entitled 'Electrochemical rehabilitation of steel reinforced concrete structures', explains the primary causes of steel reinforcement corrosion in concrete and the various remedial options that are available.

The second presentation, entitled 'Structural strengthening with fibre reinforced polymers', provides an overview of structural strengthening using fibre reinforced polymers (FRP) composite materials.

The third programme, entitled 'The route to a successful concrete repair', which has been in place for a number years now, has recently been updated in line with BS EN 1504.
